

KCC COMMUNITY WARDEN REPORT – SEPTEMBER 2022

- 1) Regular welfare visits to elderly/vulnerable residents.
- 2) Ongoing neighbour dispute – Optivo aware.
- 3) Advised resident to take tame ferret they had found to 'Happy Pants' animal rescue centre.
- 4) Advertised for wool donations on village social media sites for elderly resident who knits blankets for dementia patients. Collected and delivered donations to her.
- 5) Supported elderly residents who live in outer lanes who had been cold called by travellers who told them their roof needed attention.
- 6) Youths hand bag stolen from recreation ground- Police aware.
- 7) Cornerstone (café in church every third Thursday morning) resident numbers now increasing again since lockdown.
- 8) Advised elderly resident on costs and procedures you need to make when wanting to sell your home and move to a new one.
- 9) Supported Eastern European family who feel they have been victimised for years by neighbouring resident. They are now very upset due to unfairly receiving enforcement notice from SBC. Made Richard aware of latest claims by neighbour etc.
- 10) Neighbour dispute regarding noise and cooking smells – Advice given to resident.
